- To liaise, consult with and inform parents and the community matters relating to the curriculum as necessary including Home-School Agreements.
- To oversee arrangements for educational visits, including the appointment of a named co-ordinator.
- To receive reports from relevant personnel with regard to welfare of pupils, pupil attendance and pastoral links within school, to monitor, evaluate and review current practice.
- To review school policies relating to curriculum and pupil welfare.
- To ensure governors with individual responsibility for curriculum areas are included in discussions, or are provided with information which is in their interest.
