



## Terms of reference for Safe guarding committee

To ensure that the school carry out their functions with a view to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children; and have regard to the statutory guidance issued by the Secretary of State in considering what arrangements they need to make for the purpose of that as advise in Section 175 of the Education Act 2002, and regulations under section 157.

To monitor the schools safeguarding policies and procedures to ensure that they take into account statutory guidance (Keeping Children Safe in Education), local Authority guidance and any locally agreed inter agency procedures.

To monitor that school is identifying and recording any welfare concerns about a child.

To monitor that school is working with multi agencies to share and receive information regarding individual children in order to protect them from harm as advised in Working together to safeguard children 2018.

To monitor safeguard training of staff so that all staff have the relevant level of safe guarding training.

To monitor that the school complies with CSCP by undertaking safeguarding audits.

To monitor central safe guarding record

To monitor number of children currently involved with outside agencies

To monitor the safer handling of children records
